Deep reddish brown ale brewed with Maris Otter barley, dark crystal and amber malts plus Torrified wheat. Pioneer hops help to create a rich velvety smooth beer with hints of roasted nuts and fruity floral aromas.

Saffron Saffron Citra

Golden Ale - 3.8% ABV

Light golden ale. Brewed with citra hops to create a grapefruit aroma with a crisp gooseberry finish

Golden Ale - 4% ABV

A deep golden, very hoppy bitter, full bodied with a satisfying maltiness and a floral, lemon and herb aroma. Hops: Sorachi Ace (US) Malts: Maris Otter, Vienna

English Bitter - 3.9% ABV

Porter - English - 4.2% ABV

Billericay Vanilla Woods

Porter - English - 4.2% ABV

Woody's Wag session Porter with fresh vanilla pods added.

Billericay Coffee Porter

Porter - English - 5.9% ABV

Porter with a very strong coffee flavour

Billericay Chilli Porter

Porter - Other - 5.9% ABV

Porter with fresh chilli added to give flavour of chilli without too much heat.

Billericay Chapel Street Porter

Porter - Other - 5.9% ABV

Rich dark porter with chocolate, coffee & other complex flavours.

Billericay Mayflower Gold

Pale Ale - American - 6.5% ABV

American style Pale Ale brewed with British and American hops. This is Billericay Brewery Company's first beer.

Billericay Rhythm Stick

Red Ale - American Amber - 4.8% ABV

Hoppy rich amber ale with caramel flavour.

Cask Ales

Pale Ale - English - 3.8% ABV

Easy-drinking session ale with slight smoky notes.

A balanced amber ale with biscuit notes.

Leigh On Sea Legra Pale

Pale Ale - American - 3.8% ABV

A light, fresh and sessionable golden ale. Single hopped during the boil and following fermentation with lashings of Citra hops for a clean citrus flavour. Unfiltered and vegan friendly. Available in Keykeg, cask and bottle.

Fyne Ales Jarl

Blonde Ale - 3.8% ABV

Brewed for the first time in 2010 as a festival special for FyneFest, Jarl is a full on citrus experience and a cracking session beer. Jarl is single hopped with Citra, a vibrant and powerful American hop that gives the beer a very distinctive citrus flavour and aroma.

Dark Star American Pale Ale

Pale Ale - American - 4.7% ABV

The yeast strain used for the brewing of this American style pale ale is specially imported from the USA, along with Cascade, Centennial and Chinook hops. The low colour Maris Otter malt provides a perfect light colour and dryness to complement the crisp taste and full aroma of the hops. SERIOUSLY FULL OF HOPS!

Cider - 4.5% ABV

Perry - 5% ABV

A 5.0% ABV medium sweet perry made from a variety of dessert pears to give a refreshing, easy drinking perry. The name is from the place the pears were grown, Galanthus Farm. Galanthus being the Latin for snowdrop. The bulbs are grown and harvested from under the pear trees.
